

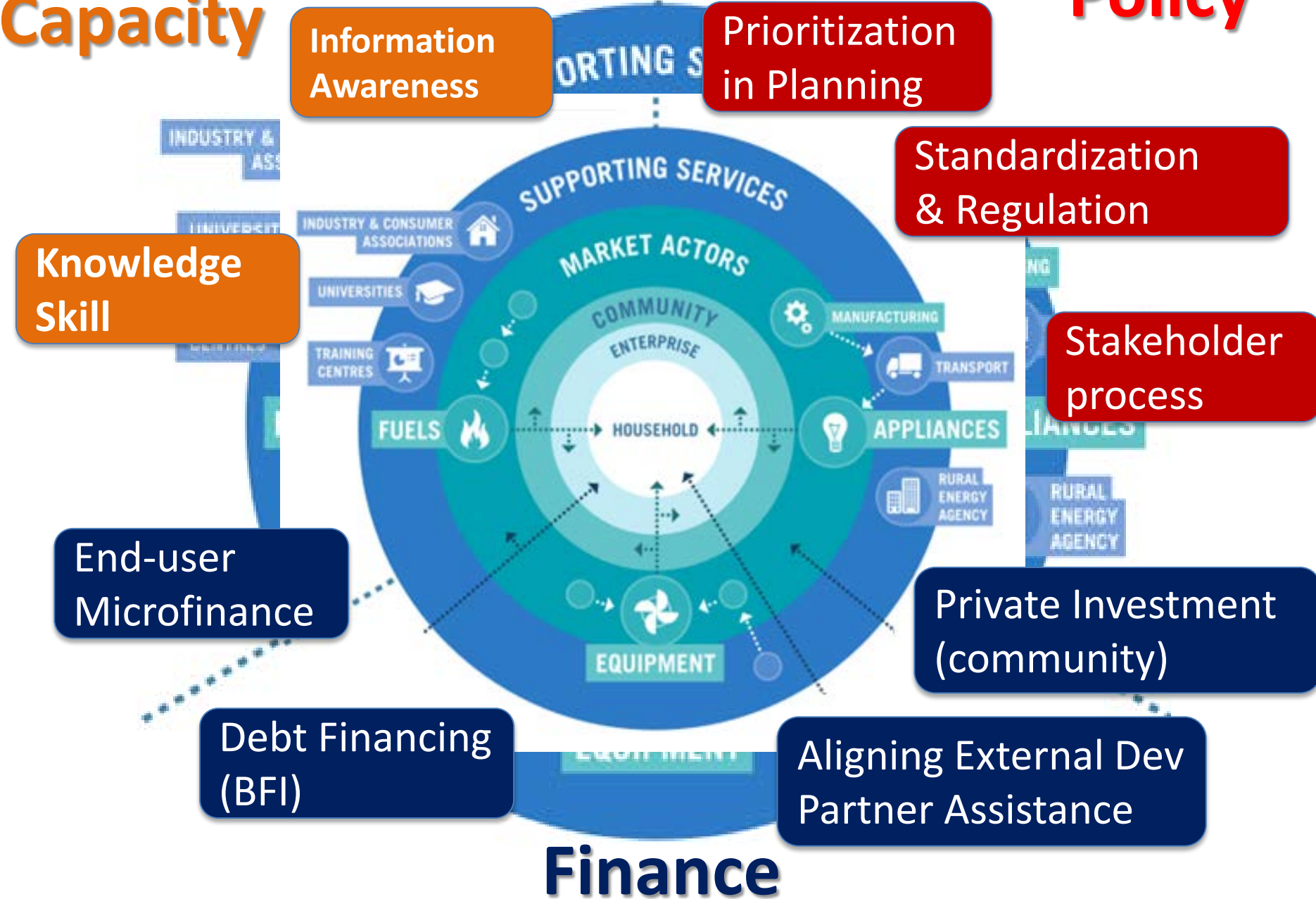

Training Centers and Capacity Building Issues and Challenges

- In-house capacity and service out-source
- Who to train?

- Balance of formal and informal trainings, and ensuring hands-on trainings

Project stages

- Conceptualization:
 - Objective (access, demand (consumptive and productive), resource assessment, technology, timeframe)
- Detail designing:
 - Technology)
 - Business model (financing, profitability, risk management, growth)
- Construction
 - Civil construction, Fabrication, installation, imports
- O&M
 - Management (HR, Financial, debt service)
 - Demand realization (productive use/capacity utilization factor)
