Population





- West Bank: 2,600,000
 Gaza Strip: 1,500,000
 Total : 4,100,000
- These numbers include Palestinians in Palestinian territories only .





Palestinian Municipalities pre-date the PA and provide key services to 74% of the total population

- Difficult political situation in Palestine (under occupation).
- Low per capital income.



• Lack of qualified and trained EE engineers for the time being.

- For many of the services they provide, there is limited cost recovery.
- Other sources of revenue are limited and therefore, municipalities have high deficits.
- Due to on going conflict and rising poverty levels, the ability of municipalities to introduce fees is constrained.
- Municipalities interested in introducing savings to their ongoing expenditures.
- Hence, the Energy Efficiency pilot.



- The Energy Efficiency Pilot is part of the MDLF's Municipal Development Program (MDP).
- The MDP provides performance based grants for capital investments and Technical Assistance to enhance management practices.
- The MDP also includes a component for promoting innovation and efficiency. The program is testing innovative approaches to enhance municipal revenue generation by reducing operational costs through the promotion of energy efficiency initiatives.


Electricity Consumption

 Remarkable decline in electricity consumption since Sept/2000 (2nd Intifada) as a result of negative growth rate of the domestic product and the high level of poverty.

Electricity Consumption per Capita(MWh)






Electricity Prices Comparison

Municipal Development & Lending Fund Global indicators (ref:World Energy Outlook 2008)

- Cities contribution to 67% world's primary energy demand and 71% of global carbon emissions.
- Energy use in cities expected to grow to 73% by 2030.

Current Status

- Palestinian municipalities spent 2.56% (2070 and 2.31% (2008) on street lighting. (Palestinian municipalities spent 1.5 million \$)
- Direct strong city government on water supply, wastewater treatment, solid waste management, public lighting (street, traffic, parks..) and public buildings.
- Lack of adequate planning and design methods .
- Limited technical and risk management skills.







Expected Results

- Reducing the targeted street lighting electricity consumption by 30%
- Reducing the targeted pumps electricity consumption by 25%.
- Reducing the targeted buildings energy consumption by 35%.
- Reducing the annual maintenance cost for the three sectors by 40%.
- Improving the municipalities and MDLF staff, skills in EE applications.
- Encourage both selected and not selected municipalities to invest in EE applications.
- Determining the feasibility of using renewable energy resources like solar energy in street lighting and water heating in public buildings.







Impact on Poverty

- Savings will encourage the municipalities to cover social services programs , especially the poor's programs.
- Reducing the cost of water pumping can be reflected on the water prices.
- Public awareness activities will help the consumers to reduce the electricity consumption cost.
- EE investments will create new jobs in the cities.

Key Activities of the Pilot

- The pilot was designed with close guidance from ESMAP (international consultant), providing technical assistance to MDLF
- First mission of ESMAP International Consultant at design stage
- Subsequent missions at key points during implementation
- Continual remote guidance and TA to MDLF staff

Project Activities صنيوق تيط وير وإقراض البلديات Municipal Development & Lending Fund



- International firm (Energy Management Services Jordan) to carry out energy audit of pilot municipalities. Final reports to include summary of investments in all municipalities for comparison.
- Procurement and installation of equipment based on auditors recommendations.
 - Large municipalities 150,000 to 300,000 \$
 - Small municipalities 50,00 to 150,000 \$
- Measurement & verification of use of new technology
- Evaluation of the process and Dissemination of knowledge to other municipalities.

Two Large cities population >25,000 were selected: Two small municipalities (population < 25,000):

• Selection criteria :

- 1. Absolute electricity consumption 40%
- 2. Electricity cost as x% of operating budget 40%
- 3. Track record of implementing MDLF projects 20%

Selected cities

- 1- Hebron
- **Street lighting;** Ein Sarah street, Korbet Zahda (Multiple Streets- 4-6 km)
- Water \sewage pumps, Beir El-Safee WPstation, Al-Rameh Sewage Station, El-Hesba Sewage Station
- **Public Buildings:** Slaughter house, Municipal Building and Children Cultural Center (Isa'ad El-Tofolah

- 2- Qalqilia
- Street lighting; Al-Gharbee, Al-Sabe'e and Tulkarem Streets
- Water Pumps; Slaughter House pump, Sewage Pump
- **Public Buildings;** The public park (zoo), Municipal Building

3- Jericho

- Street Lighting, Al- Seil Station, Al-Maghtas(Baptism) Road, Jerusalem Road Amman Road (The main East Entrance of Jericho City)
- **Public Building**, Municipality Building, Library Building, The Spanish Park
- Pump Stations , Domestic WP, Irrigation Pump, The South Elevated Reservoir

4- Anabta

- Street lighting; Tulkarem Nablus Street Al-Sabe'e Street
- Water Pumps; Kofor Rumman WP stationBeir. (1) Station Beir. (2) Station

- Possible street-lighting in all Municipalities
 - 1350 street-lighting
 - 5 pumping stations systems
 - 600 public building lighting

Resulting in an annual saving of:

500,000 KWh in street lighting

18,000 KWh in Water and sewage pumping

40,000 KWh in public building lighting

Project Implementation Plan

Measurement and Verification

- Deploying M&V plan during the energy audit stage.
- Using simple components of international protocol (International Performance M&V Protocol)

Process Evaluation

- MDLF will appoint an international expert to carry out process evaluation, including site visits, interviews with stakeholders and a final recommendations to scale up.
- Organize stakeholder workshop involving Palestinian Energy Authority, private sector, municipalities and donors.

Other activities

Training to municipalities staff and MDLF

Proposed Methodology

- Data collection plan.
- Centralizing the regulations and auditing processes.
- Parallel way work.
- Measurable goals in applicable plans.
- Protecting the social interests.
- Consideration of environment needs.

Recommendations

- Developing data base for implementing EE technologies in Palestine, which are applicable under local and national planning requirements and conditions.
- Integrating the implementation of EE applications of ongoing rehabilitation processes for projected consumptions.
- Promoting energy efficiency applications and awareness as a remarkable input in saving energy.

Recommendations

- Invest in promotion strategy, focusing on potential investors.
- Strengthen existing related firms like research centers.
- Promote global and regional cooperation and the exchange of information.
- Develop relative laws and bylaws.
