Sources of Information:

PCN; gender disaggregated data

Example: Women as Lighting Services Entrepreneurs

The project development objective is to facilitate development of sustainable business models to bring efficient, clean and affordable lighting services to the rural poor. The project will assist enterprises in developing business models, and facilitate access to financial resources, that deliver a wide array of innovative and appropriate modern lighting products to rural off grid households and businesses in three rural areas. This is a new businesses opportunity and offers the potential for income generation by a number of entrepreneurs. Women in the chosen locations are known to be entrepreneurial since they are very active in the informal sector but they lack access to resources, such as collateral required for bank loans, and business skills, to help them make the transition into the formal sector.
