## AFREA Gender & Energy: Action to date

- Mali: AMADER Gender and energy needs assessment completed and action plan being developed; gender desk in AMADER established.
- Tanzania: REA Gender Awareness workshop held;
  survey REA staff perceptions of gender within REA
- Senegal: draft methodology and lessons learned from gender mainstreaming in IDA energy projects prepared & used as good practice model in Benin & Liberia
- Kenya: gender and energy survey module developed & tested – forms template in toolkit; discussing support to Min Energy on gender mainstreaming

## AFREA Gender & Energy: Action to date

- **Benin**: scoping mission completed linked to project *Modernizing Biomass Energy Services*; gender assessment and capacity building under consideration
- Liberia: Rapid gender assessment completed; support for gender mainstreaming RREA under consideration
- Biomass Energy Initiative for Africa (BEIA): Incorporate gender dimension into AFTEG biomass strategy; gender training for relevant stakeholders
